f.u.n.k.e. AVIONICS GmbH FAA / EASA TSO Update

The European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) and U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) have updated the reciprocal bilateral agreement called (TIP) – Technical Implementation Procedure.

This agreement allows the recognition of each authority's regulatory systems. This means that all new f.u.n.k.e. AVIONICS GmbH products carrying ETSO approval no longer feature or require separate TSO certification.

A f.u.n.k.e. AVIONICS GmbH ETSO product can now be installed by a qualified U.S. facility, without the need for a separate TSO listing.
